

Lakewood Performing Arts Council
Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, June 8, 2010 –7:00 PM

Call to Order –

The meeting was called to order by President, Liz Evans at 7:07 PM. Chuck Stephen, Director; Marnie Rollins, Vice-President; Mike Noyes, Treasurer; Monica Nedbalski, Secretary; Shawn DeJong, Bingo Liaison; Rena Thomas, Ann Fattor, Kylie Fattor and Tami Lack were present.

The May, 2010 meeting minutes were read and approved by Mike Noyes, and seconded by Shawn DeJong.

Director's Report –

The POPS concert was awesome, and almost completely sold out. There are DVDs of the Wednesday night show available for purchase.

Regarding POPS; Chuck is looking into changing venues for next year, in order to accommodate the growing number of people coming to see the show, and to have it on one evening instead of three or four. Possible locations for the show include the West Bowles Community Church, or the Lakewood Cultural Center. The chosen location would have to be big enough to seat more than 1,500 people.

The Symphonic Orchestra was invited to play at CMEA next January; congratulations to everyone for all of their hard work!

President's Report –

The ice cream social after band camp on June 5th went very well; there was a good showing from the parents. The show-and-tell was awesome; it is going to be an exciting year for the Regiment!

The new parent social before band camp also went well, with 8-10 people showing up. Steve Doppler would like to host a parent social at his house in the near future, possibly on the Saturday before the final band camp.

We are planning to have a potluck for all Bengal Regiment members/family members on Friday, August 13, which is the last day of band camp for this year.

Old Business –

The Orlando trip planning is progressing as scheduled; no updates at this time.

New Business –

We need a catering manager for the 2010 season (and forward!). Anyone who is interested should contact Liz Evans, or any Board member.

The next band camp is scheduled for July 9-10; there is a massive water gun fight planned for band members on July 9th, which should cool things off quite a bit. Anyone out there during the fight will be considered fair game!

There will also be another margarita social for parents before the show-and-tell on July 10th; thanks to Tammy Lack and Ann Fattor for organizing everything!

Fundraisers –

Regarding Bingo; the next Must-Go is scheduled for June 19th. Bingo is doing ok, but is not up to the level that it was 3 years ago. More volunteers are coming in to work, in order to earn points for the upcoming Orlando trip. New parents should be reminded that they need to sign up to work/train before they come to the bingo hall. Since the schedule is filled in advance, there is no room to accommodate anyone just dropping in.

Regarding King Soopers cards; Shari and Bob O’Connell will be in charge of the cards this season, taking over from Cindy Aragon.

The kids sold approximately 325 Butterbraids during the last fundraiser; there will be another Butterbraid fundraiser in November, with delivery the week before Thanksgiving.

The pizza kit fundraiser is scheduled for September, after the kids are back in school. The cost is \$25.00/kit, with \$9.00 of that total going into the kids accounts for each one sold. There will be prizes given in different areas, such as top-selling individual, group, etc. All money earned during this fundraiser will go directly towards the Orland trip; the Color Guard will be allowed to participate, since they are considered a part of the Bengal Regiment.

We will discuss the possibility of doing a solicitation letter for donations after school starts. This type of fundraiser has the potential for great success, and could include donations from Lakewood Alumni. There will be more information coming on this in the near future.

Treasurer’s Report –

According to Mike Noyes, the ending May balance was \$2,000.20; however, there are still \$5,000 - \$6,000 in deposits to add to this amount.

The Fans Funds balance was \$300.33 at the time of this meeting.
