**Meeting Minutes**

***Call to Order –***

***Treasurer’s Report –***

According to Mike Noyes, the opening June balance was \$11,109.29, which included revenues from Solo and Ensemble, BR/WG/WP fees and Butterbraid proceeds. The ending June balance was \$7,650.14; however, this does not include Drums Along The Rockies payments. We should start July with a balance of approximately \$10,000.00.

The FANS Fund balance is currently 300.33 points.
